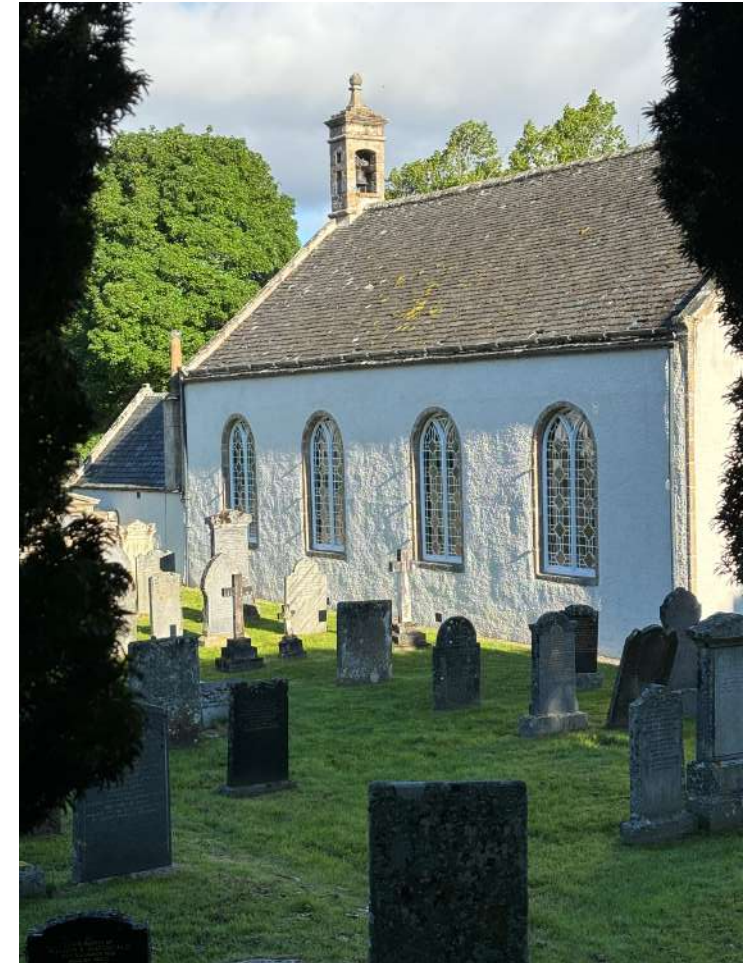
Projects- Tea in the Park
